



A Draught of a Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Two. Containing in Breadth North and South on the West Side of Duke Street Sixty feet, and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Eastward by Duke Street, Northward by Lot Number One Hundred and One, Westward by a Twenty feet Alley, and Southward by Lot Number One Hundred-three. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 3^d. day of May 1776 for Durst Pfister
