



A Draught of a Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred & - Twelve Containing in Breadth East and West on Penn Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South on Duke Street Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Eastward by Duke Street, Northward by a Twenty-foot Alley, Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Eleven, and Southward by Penn Street. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 3^d day of May 1776 for Durst Pfister —
