


FORM NO. I.



Situate on Flintstone Creek, in Southampton township Bedford County, containing 189 acres 120 perches and allowance of 6 percent for roads &c, being part of a tract that originally contained 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres and allowance. Surveyed the 21st of May 1767, on order No 1982 granted in the name of Mathew Mease, dated the 26th of November 1766. Returned the 3rd of September 1853. (To be patented to Archibald Perdew.)
