


FORM NO. 1.



The above Draught made by the black lines contains ten acres and twenty five perch. of Land and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in Little Britain Township Lancaster County, and is part of a larger Tract said to contain 212 acres and allowance granted to Henry Parsons by warrant dated March the 20th 174 3/4. (The dotted lines represent the other part of said larger tract) and now surveyed for the Heirs of Joseph Price dec'd this 25th day of March 1843 — To Jacob Sallade Esq. — By James Calwell — Surveyor General Penna.
