February 11th 1829. for William Vance Esq. Administrator of W. Harvey Decd. (it is owned and Occupied by Daniel Moore of the Borough of Washington) and Contains Sixty nine Acres. & 75 perches & Allowance of 6ix pr Cent, The Compartments. A. & B. represented by the Dotted lines. are Owned, & Occupied, by William Quail and James Orr Esq. ~ Quail's part Contains 225 Acres & 57 perches. and was Returned in two seperate Surveys by W.
