


Mountain or William Campble



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Fannet Township Franklin County Containing Two hundred and two acres and the usual Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed May 23rd 1810 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Mary Paul Dated December 14th 1801.

N.B. The part of the above survey laying north of the Run is claimed by W^m Gammel as said Run being previously established a concentable boundary. The whole whereof is claimed by William Campble on Warrant granted to Peter Rennell Dated March 7th 1794.
