Barret, the part marked C. being an interference on the Francis McConnel Survey, on an order of Survey dated Sept 15th 1766 Nº 1227. and the part marked D. being and interference on the George Goodwin Survey, on an order of Survey dated July 29 1767 No. 4107. and owned by the heirs of Jacob Wilhelm Sen Dec ! Surveyed the above part for Wm. H. Mc Cormack. Sept. 24. 1764.
