



A draught of a tract of land called the Vineyard situate "in the Long Limestone Valley where the Indian or Traders path from the Bald Eagles "Nest towards Frankstown adjoining and southward of" land surveyed for "John Taylor .. including a spring," on both sides of Trout Run in Cumberland County: containing two hundred and eighty eight acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads surveyed October 25<sup>th</sup> 1770 for Alexander Robinson in pursuance of an order N<sup>o</sup> 1178 dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769
