



A draught of a tract of land called the Vineyard situate in "the Long Limestone Valley where the Indian or traders path passes from the Bald Eagle's Nest" towards Frankstown, about nine miles from the said Nest adjoining and North East of Land surveyed for Alexander Robinson and on both sides of Trout Run in Cumberland County containing two hundred and seventy eight acres and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed October 25th 1770 for John Taylor Merchant in pursuance of an order No 1838 dated the 3^d day of April 1769
