



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor dated the 22nd day of October Anno Dom 1737 the above described tract of land was surveyed
in Lancaster County unto John Lewis and is situate in Robinson Township, on a branch of French Creek beginning at a white oak thence north 20° west by vacant land 122 perches to a small hickery thence north 70 degrees east by vacant land 140 perches to a post thence south 20 degrees east by vacant land or the land of widow Roberts 122 perches to a post thence south 70 degrees west by vacant land one hundred and forty perches to the place of beginning.
containing one hundred acres beside ye usual allowance for roads.
