

A draught of forty seven acres and ten perches and allowed being part of a strip of land cutt off from the Honble Richard Penns Manor at TUIpehocoon in Berks County and numbered in a general plan of the same Nº10 returned into the Secretarys Office the 26th of October 1770 for George Reed by warrant dated 18th instant

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of 1906
