

A draught of a tract of land situate in Newbury Township in the County of York surveyed the 7th day of September 1786 to George Miller in pursuance of a warrant granted to Adam Miller bearing date the 16th day of October 1766 containing fifty acres & seventy eight perches & the usual allowance of Six Acres P Cent for roads &c.2
