

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1785, entitl'd an act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common<sup>t</sup> Wealth, and by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>t</sup> the Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of Sep<sup>r</sup> 1785 the above described Tract of two hundred Acres of Land & all<sup>t</sup> or of Six P.C<sup>t</sup> for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> DCCCXIX. situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 4 on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
