

Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania Passed the 24th day of Feb^r 1785, entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops of this Common^{wealth}" and by order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Hon^t the Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 30th day of August 1781, the above described Tract of two hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six P.C. for Roads &c. No DCCXCII situate in District N^o. 4 on the West side of the Allegany river in the County of West Moreland.
