


Lot, N<sup>o</sup>. MCLXXXII

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, "An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the Nineteenth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. No. 1182 situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
