


Lott No 1025



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops in this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785, the above described Tract of Two Hundred acres of Land & Allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent for Roads &c N<sup>o</sup> XXIV Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 5 on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
