
FORM No. 1. DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No.6.

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donohon-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth, and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honographe the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the fifth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six Ber Cent for Roads, &c. No.1098 situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
