

Situate in Lannar township Centre County Containing two hundred and sixty five acres, one hundred and thirty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 14th day of October 1819 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Fabb dated the 5th day of October A.D. 1819.

The improvements on the above described tract of land, at the time of making the survey, consisted of a Cabin house and Barn, about 75 or 80 acres of Cleared land, John Fabb and his family residing on the same, he says that he has resided on the same for sixteen years last past, and that it was first improved in the year 1801.
