


FORM NO. I.



In Pursuance of a warrant granted to James Robison Bearing date the 19th day of December 1811, Survey'd for — The 12th day of December following the above described tract of land containing one hundred & two acres & sixtysix perches & nine tenths of a perch. Including a dwelling house & barn & about fifty acres of land cleared & fenced with other improvements thereon first commenced about the year 1787. Situate on Donegal Township the waters of the Four Mile run in Donegal Township in the County of Westmoreland
