


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Chancery Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 20 a. & 98 perches and the usual allowance &c. Originally surveyed by William Hersey late D.S. on the 29th of the 10th month A.D. 1795. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Ross bearing date the 12th day of September A.D. 1791, directed to be surveyed in one two or three pieces. And now at the request of the owner the said William Ross the same has been calculated, examined and found to be correct and at his request returned for confirmation the 20th day of July A.D. 1814.
