



The above Draft describes a Tract or Parcel of Land situate in Guilford Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in the County of Cumberland) containing one hundred and forty nine Acres and 149 Perches and the Allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c formerly claimed under the application of John Reynolds Esqr No 2456 Dated the 16th Day of January 1767, which application is alleged to have included the whole of the present survey although (as is said) a Part of the same, to wit, the South End has been formerly Survey'd under a location to a certain George Gits posterior to that of John Reynolds, and a Patent granted in pursuance thereof by the late Proprietaries - Survey'd February 24th 1791.
