

The above is a draft of a tract of Land which was surveyed to George Rapp and his associates on the 21st day of October 1808 by virtue of their warrant dated October 4th 1808 containing three hundred and thirteen acres and 31 perches and allowance of six per cent &c including their actual settlement and improvement situate in Conequinessing Township in the County of Butler being lot No 45 in Nicholsons District and adjoining lot No 46 in Alexanders District.
