


FORM NO. I.



By virtue of a warrant dated the fifteenth day of February Anno Dom^m 174^{2/3}, the above described Tract of land was surveyed unto Hans Jerig Sparn in Erle Township in Lancaster County Beginning at a Corner of ye land of Leonard Ailmaker thence S. 15 Deg⁵ West by ye same 52 perches to a Black Oak then by the land of James Young E.S.E. 54 per² to a White Oak and South 12 Degrees East 81 perches to a Black Oak thence East by North by Vacant land 84 perches to a Post in Andrew Caldwell's line then on ye same and by Vacant land N. by West 120 per to a Chesnut Oak then by Vacant land N.W. by W. 154 p² to a white oak and S. 40² W. 30 P. to a post in said Aylmakers line yⁿ on ye same S. E. 57 P. to ye place of Beg. Cont^t 109.⁰⁰ & all^e 18th of 6 month 1743.
