 North West seventy ^{eight} ~~three~~ perches to a post thence by land of Godlieb Herger.
 North East one hundred and three perches to a post, thence by land of Chri-
 stian Geatzandcanor South East forty six perches to a white oak thence by land
 of Jacob Hubbaugh South West twenty perches to a post thence by ^{sd} Hubbaugh's
 land South East Thirty two perches to a post thence by land of Joseph Groves
 South West eighty three perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing forty th-
 ree acres with the usual allowance of six P. Cent.
