

 Warrant granted to Roger M<sup>c</sup>Kinney dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1744. And since

 Peter Mathias late deceased. And now on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1864. being requi-  
 ested by the present Owner Peter Mathias, to make return of the above, for Patenting  
 &c.
