The above Draft represents all that remains of the two tracts Originally surveyed to John Reed on his separate Warrants dated June 21<sup>st</sup> 1786 and the returns showing one tract 112<sup>as</sup> 12 ps. and the other 70<sup>as</sup> 80 ps. & allow. Jacob and John Bitner Executors of Christian Bitner are in possession of 28<sup>as</sup> 37 ps. and allow which is a part of both tracts and James C. Mauck in his own right and John McClintock Administrator of Andrew McClintock are in possession of and own 15<sup>as</sup> 105 ps. & allow. of John Reed, the 112<sup>as</sup> 12<sup>p</sup> tract as above represented in Lamar Township Clinton Co.
