

Surveyed April 18-1870 in pursuance of a warrant granted to C.S. Richardson and Joshua R. Jones dated the 28-day of March A.D. 1870

Remark The strip marked "J. Jones & Hoge is a piece for which a warrant was issued about 1864 to parties named thereon - A survey was made by - Paul a deputy of WM Hilands a former surveyor of Venango of which this was formerly a part.
