



A draft of ninety seven acres and one perch of land with six per cent for roads situate in Greenwood township in Mifflin County surveyed 12<sup>th</sup> January 1807 in pursuance of a warrant to Thomas Patton dated 3<sup>d</sup> January 1797. NOTE there were people living on the above represented land at time of survey some land cleared and grain had been raised thereon.
