In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain Lands; and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the Hand & Seal of Office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania bearing <sup>date</sup> at Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of Land containing two hundred & Sixteen Acres & one hundred & fifty six perches and Allowance of 6 pr Cent for Roads &c was Surveyed on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1785
