

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the Hand & Seal of Office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of Land containing two hundred & sixteen Acres & one hundred & fifty Six perches and Allowance of 6 pr. cent for Roads &c was Surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 1785 by
