


## Donation Land



Situate on a Head Branch of Camp Creek Between the first Parallel and the Northern Boundary in that Part of District No. 3 to me Allotted on the north Side of the River Ohio. Being part of the Land Appropriated for the purpose of Redeeming and paying off the Certificates of depreciation &c. Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 pursuant to Instructions from John Lukens Esquire Surveyor Gen! dated at Philadelphia the fifth day of March 1785.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty fifth day of October 1906.
