


Part of District No 3



In pursuance of An Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein Mentioned. And by virtue of A Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Penn<sup>a</sup> to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the Above tract of land containing two hundred Acres And Allowance of 6p Cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
