

Containing four Hundred & Eighteen Acres  $\frac{3}{4}$  & Allowe of Six p.Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for Capt. John Paul Schott the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1785 in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1785.
