



Situate on the Hurricane branch of Dunning's Creek in Napier township Bedford County containing 40 acres 23 perches & 85 allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c.

Originally surveyed in 1793 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Joseph Rowser for 40 acres dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 1793. Resurveyed by Michael Reed Esq. according to the original marks upon the ground the 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1850 for Samuel Pitchey the present owner of the land.
