A draught of a tract of land situate in Reading town-ship in the County of York surveyed the 23d September 1790 for Isaac Latsha in pursuance of a warrant granted to Yost Runk dated the 21st day of January 1790 containing one hundred and ninety seven acres and allowance of six acres & cent for roads & N.B. The improvement on this land has been made thirty five years but no warrant has ever been had thereon therefor interest to Commence from the 21st day of January 1755.
