

In pursuance of an application bearing date April 3d 1769 N°2472 surveyed on the 27th day of October 1788 unto John Robinson in right of Thomas McMullen Sent the above discribed tract of land situate on the waters of Sewickly-in Huntington township in the County of Westmoreland containing three hundred acres & of an acre and allowance of six pr. cent for roads &c.
