



The above is a draught of a survey made Decr 10<sup>th</sup> 1834 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Ruckman for 20 acres dated Novr 12<sup>th</sup> 1834 containing nineteen acres and 145 perches and allowance of six per cent. Situate in Amwell township Washington County Pa. on the waters of Ten mile creek.

NOTE; there is an actual settlement and improvement on the premises old Mr Ruckman's (the owners father) house is on the ground but made to executing the warrant no objections.
