

SURVEY'D TO JOHN SHAW ON THE 13<sup>TH</sup> JULY 1787

The above the above Described Tract of Two hundred  
and thirty <sup>two</sup> acres and three Quarters of an acre and al-  
lowance of six Pr. Cent. Situate about three miles be-  
low land granted to George Kimmell and adjoin-  
ing the Southerly side to land said to be Survey'd  
for Elliott and Cowdon and to include Crooked Creek  
and the mouth of a large run emptying in on the  
Southerly side thereof in Armstrong Township —  
Westmoreland County by warrant of the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of  
February 1776 — Joshua Elder D.S.
