



The above Draught includes a Survey of 184<sup>ac</sup> & allowance made the 14<sup>th</sup> of the 10<sup>th</sup> mo. 1743. In Pursuance of a warrant Granted to John Pig-gott, bearing Date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1737, the Right of which passed thro' Sundry Hands, and at length was purchased by Richard Sted-man, who obtained a warrant bearing Date the 16<sup>th</sup> of August 1749 to include some vacancies adjoining the said Former Survey, in Pursuance whereof the Quantity of 7.2<sup>ac</sup> allowance was added, making in the whole 256<sup>ac</sup> allowance as above ~~certify~~ mentioned-
