ifie that Moses Smith is entitled to Two hundred and fifty acres of land
on the East side of Yohog^g river opposite the Bradford adjoining
the Land of Providence Mounts, Wm. McKee Wm. Crawford and Philip
Mason to include his Settlement made in the year one thousand seven hun-
dred and seventy three — Given under our hands at Redstone Old fort this 5th
day of Jan^y 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth — —

Entd 5th January 1780 Retd 15th April 1788.
