

A draft of a tract of land situate in Upper Mount bethel Town-ship in the County of Northampton Originally Surveyed the 2d December 1759 to Jacob Sneider in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 24 January 1759. containing one hundred and sixty-five Acres sixteen perches & allowance of six & Cent &c. Resurveyed and divided the 23 d June 1792 between Henry Dills and Samuel Kikendale. Henry Dills part containing fifty-four Acres thirty perches and the allowance of Six & Cent &c.
