

Situate on the Waters of Lich inturkey foot Township. Somerset County. Including an Improvement first begun the Ist day of May 1808. Whereon afamily had resided and raised grain before the date of the Warrant & had Continued their residence there on until the time of the Survey - And Surveyed the 27 day of September 1816. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 22 nd day of June 1812. Granted to James Skinner at 50/8 hundred acres - Yet it Blends with the tract John Skinner (of Samuel) in Settlement at patenting this being like that, subject to £ 10 & hundred acres & Interest from the 1 st day of March /779.
