


FORM NO. 1.



Situated on Ned's Run Waters of Quernahoning Creek and on both sides of the Great Road leading from Bedford to Pittsburgh in Quernahoning Township Bedford County and surveyed the 19th day of August 1786. And returned into the Surveyor-General's office in consequence of a warrant for 300 ^{ac}s dated the 6th day of September 1784 on the waters of Sandy Run Bounded by lands of Edward Higgins to the North-East and the fallen Timber on the North-West in Quernahoning Township Bedford County which Right could not be satisfied agreeable to the location thereof by reason of Prior Rights and surveys made formerly for John Musser & Comp^y. Therefore the above survey was made at the request of John Roberts the present owner and in pursuance of an Act of Assembly in favor of unsatisfied Rights within the limits of the Old Purchase.
