

A Draught of a tract of Land situate in Union Township Mifflin County  
 Survey'd the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1797 by James Harris late Deputy Surveyor in  
 pursuance of a warrant granted to William Stewart dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of  
 January 1796 resurveyed agreeable to the old lines the 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> days of April  
 1801 and appears to contain Forty seven acres and 85 perches and the  
 allowance of six pr cent for Roads &c.
