



The above two tracts are Situate in Tyrone township Originally Surveyd on one warrant dated the 20th June 1793 for 150 $\frac{1}{2}$ Acre Granted to Casper Kemp & Abm. Smith which appears to have been divided between said parties at the time and the dotted part of 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ Acre Allotted to Abm. Smith which is patented; The other part was Casper Kemp's and Contained 109 $\frac{1}{2}$ 150 $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ Acre Allowance which Now On Resurvey Contains One hundred eighteen Acres and eighty eight perches and Allowance Resurveyed for Return the 22 Oct^r 1822
