

rant granted to John Strauss dated the 18th day of February A.D. 1824, situated in Hopewell
Township Beaver County containing Six acres and Eighty five perches and allowance of six
Per Cent &c. I Ross W^m Law Deputy Surveyor Do certify that at the time of Survey that there
was no improvement on the Ground that was made by Strauss or any person for him there was a
man by the name of Lowry had an improvement on the ground which he made a few days before
I went to Execute the Warrant given under my hand
