


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Manheim Township in the County of York, Containing 17° and 137 P.s and allowance &c being part of a larger Tract of Land Originally surveyed by Archibald McClean late D.S. on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June A.D. 1768. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 50° Granted to Jacob Ullamer bearing date the Thirtieth day of August A.D. 1750, and since resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land. And now at the request of the Present Owner Philip Miller, We are desired to make return of the draught as Calculated, examined, and corrected the Eighteenth day of June Anno Domini 1808.
