

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 19th June 1809. Surveyed the 9th April 1811 to George Shupp, the above described tract of Land situate in Chesnut-hill township, Northampton County, containing forty Acres, one hundred perches and allowance of six & Cent & C

At the time George Shupp obtained the Warrant, he lived with his family on this tract & has cleared two thirds of the ground on which grain has been repeatedly raised, he has lately purchased a piece of land from Abraham Shupp adjoining the West side of this land & has removed about & perches from this tract, but continues to Cultivate this tract.
