



Situate in Mahantobingo township (formerly Berks now) Schuylkill county being part of a larger tract which was originally surveyed on the 20th day of October 1785 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Leonard Reits dated the 16th day of March 1785. Resurveyed on the 22nd day of November 1815 for the heirs of Abraham Brotius.
