



The Draught of a tract of land situe in Sugar Valley Miles Township Centre County containing four hundred & sixteen acres eighty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 20th day of May 1815, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Michael Rough dated the 30th day of September 1814.

The improvements on the above described tract of land consists of a dwelling house and stable, about ten acres of cleared land and is now occupied by George Carey and family - and by information was first improved by in the fall of the year 1802.
